### *About Songs of Sanctuary*

*Adiemus – Songs of Sanctuary* is an extended choral-type work based on the European classical tradition, but where the vocal sound is more akin to 'ethnic' or 'world' music. The idea was to have some thematic unity within the work as a whole, rather than a collection of disparate pieces in song form. The text was written phonetically with the words viewed as instrumental sound, the idea being to maximize the melisma (an expressive vocal phrase) by removing the distraction, if one can call it that, or words. The sound is universal, as is the language of music.
